MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

Management Discussion & Analysis Scope of Activity:

Libord Finance Limited is a registered Non Banking Finance Company. Over the years it has forayed into a wide spectrum of Financial and Corporate Advisory Services and established a niche for itself in providing a wide spectrum of consulting services for Corporate Finance, Project Management, Merger & Acquisition, Transfer Pricing, Rehabilitation of Sick Companies, and Matters related to Domestic and International Tax Laws, Rules and Regulations.

Opportunities & Threats

This fiscal year the general economic and business environment was marked with slower growth in major economies of the World and fluctuations in the Euro Zone. The Indian Economy did not register an impressive rate of growth this year and the business environment continued to be gloomy and uncertain. The gross capital formation, savings and investment rates all took the plunge in a difficult and somewhat depressed economy faced with heavy budget and current account deficits and continued inflationary pressures. The Reserve Bank of India which has since long been giving preference to controlling inflation in India, showed concern for growth and development this year and reduced the policy rates thrice. The repo rate was brought down by 100 basis points during the year yet the investment environment did not improve much. Perhaps, this time the lack of business and consumer confidence resulted in less than optimal growth of trade and industry which put further pressures on Indian economy as it was already reeling under tremendous pressure to perform under a difficult and gloomy global economic environment.

The Indian Economy achieved a growth rate of about 5% in 2012-2013. Though the fiscal deficit could be contained to the revised estimate of 5.3% yet it was high compared to what RBI considers as a comfortable level of about 3%. According to the data reported in the Economic Survey, the Wholesale Price Index was at a high level of 7.6 percent in 2012-2013. Industry, which includes mining and quarrying, manufacturing, electricity, gas and water supply, and construction sectors, grew at a 3.5 percent the 2011-12 fiscal year and slowed to 3.1 in the 2012-13 fiscal year. Agriculture also slowed significantly, growing at a rate of 1.8 percent, compared to 3.6 percent in the previous fiscal year. Growth in the services sector slowed to 6.6 percent in 2012-2013, compared to 8.2 percent in 2011-2012.

Hence, there has been a drop in the rate of growth in many sectors. Also there has been a decrease in corporate profits of many companies, Merger and Acquisition activity has slowed down and the new projects just are not being set up as fast as they normally would. In gloomy environment, Your company has achieved a turnover of 120.85 lakhs which is 34 % higher than 90.55 lacs achieved in the previous year. This was mainly due to increase in the revenues from the Consultancy Services provided by the Company.

Risks and Concerns

The Company is providing financial, corporate and management consultancy and undertakes wide spectrum of activities and therefore has a well diversified portfolio of services provided. Currently there are no risks faced by the Company.

Outlook

With the increasing thrust on speeding up the reform process and monetary easing along with decrease in the crude oil prices and major commodity prices in the global economy, the Indian Economy is looking poised for a better performance in the year 2013-14. The Economic Survey 2013 has stated that the Indian economy is likely to grow between 6.1 percent and 6.7 percent in the coming fiscal year. The Company sees growth opportunities for its business in the year ahead.

Financial Performance and Operational performance

We have improved our performance and focused on managing costs. The Financial performance of the Company has been satisfactory.

Review of Internal Control System and their Adequacy

The Company has internal control system which, in the opinion of the Management, is commensurate with the size and activities of the company.

Human Resource Development and Industrial Relations

The Company continues to maintain excellent industrial relations, while also ensuring human resource development. Training and educational programs are conducted regularly to improve the efficiency and productivity levels of every employee. The Board is also working on a comprehensive basis to review company's HR Policies so as to provide opportunities for the absorption of new talent in the Company. The company believes that highly motivated staff and employees represent the core strength of a consulting finance company like us and so we make every effort to inculcate and nurture good talent as a matter of our HR initiative.

Report on the Financial Statements

NOTES FORMING PART OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 31ST MARCH 2013

NOTE 1: SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

1. System of Accounting:

The accounts have been prepared on the basis of historical cost convention and on the basis of a going concern, with revenues recognized and expenses accounted on accrual basis.

2. Revenue Recognition and Expenses:

All expenses and income to the extent payable or receivable respectively are accounted for on accrual basis.

3. Fixed Assets:

Fixed Assets are stated at cost, inclusive of incidental expenses, less accumulated depreciation and Lease Terminal Adjustment.

4. Depreciation:

Depreciation on fixed assets is provided on the Straight Line Method at the rates and in the manner prescribed in Schedule XIV to the Companies Act, 1956.

5. Valuation of Investments and Stock-in-trade:

- a) Valuation of Investments:
 - Long Term Investments are valued at cost. However, provision for diminution is made to recognize a decline, other than temporary, in the value of investments, such reduction being determined and made for each investment individually.
 - ii) Current investments are valued at cost.

6. Retirement Benefits:

Defined Benefit Plans: The present value of the obligation under such plan, is determined based on an actuarial valuation using the Projected unit Credit Method. Acturial gains and losses arising on such valuation are recognized immediately in the profit & Loss Account. In Case of funded defined benefit plans, the fair value of the plan assets is reduced from the gross obligation under the defined benefit plans, to recognize the obligation on net basis.

7. Taxation:

Income-tax expense comprises current tax and deferred tax charge or credit. Provision for Current tax is made on the basis of assessable income at the tax rate applicable to the relevant assessment year. The deferred tax asset and deferred tax liability is calculated by applying tax rate and tax law that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the Balance sheet Date. Deferred tax assets arising mainly on account of brought forward losses and unabsorbed depreciation under tax laws, are recognised, only if there is a virtual certainly of its realisation, supported by Convincing evidence. Deferred tax assets on account of other timing differences are recognised only to the extent there is a reasonable certainty of its realisation. At each Balance sheet date, the carrying amount of deferred tax assets is reviewed to reassure realisation.

8. Impairment of Assets:

The carrying amounts of assets are reviewed at each balance sheet date if there is any indication of impairment based on internal/external factors. An asset is impaired when the carrying amount of the asset exceeds the recoverable amount. An impairment loss is charged to the profit and loss account in the year in which an asset is identified as impaired. An impairment loss recognized in prior accounting periods is reversed if there has been change in the estimate of the recoverable amount.

9. Borrowing Cost:

Borrowing Costs attributable to acquisition and construction of respective assets are capitalized as a part of the cost of such assets upto date when such asset is ready for its intended use. Other borrowing costs are charged to Profit & Loss Account.

10. Miscellaneous expenditure:

- a) Preliminary expenses, public issue expenses and expenses for increasing the Authorised Capital are written off over a period of five years.
- b) Deferred Revenue Expenditure is being written off over a period of five years.
